## Submission Guidelines

The Scientific Committee welcomes the submission of high-quality technical contributions related to the conference themes and tracks.

All submissions must be prepared and submitted in English only.

---

## Submission Type

TOGSE 2026 adopts the **Extended Abstract** format as the official and only submission category for conference participation.

The Extended Abstract is considered a **Mini Paper** and should present:

- A clear technical or scientific problem
- Well-defined methodology
- Quantitative results and/or technical analysis
- Relevant discussion and conclusions

Purely descriptive abstracts without technical content or evaluable results will not be accepted.

## Extended Abstract Requirements

- Language: English only
  - Length: 2–4 pages (including figures, tables, and references)
  - File Format: Microsoft Word and PDF
  - Reference Style: IEEE
  - Maximum References: 10
  - Recommended Content: At least one figure or table
  - File Naming Format:  
TOGSE2026\_LastName\_ShortTitle.docx

## Structure of the Extended Abstract

Authors are requested to organize their submissions using the following structure:

1. Title
  2. Authors and Affiliations
  3. Corresponding Author Email
  4. Abstract (150–200 words)
  5. Introduction (150–250 words)
  6. Methodology (150–300 words)
  7. Results / Expected Results (200–400 words)
  8. Discussion (150–300 words)
  9. Conclusion & Recommendations (100–200 words)
  10. Keywords (3–5 keywords)
  11. References (IEEE Style)

## Review Process

All submissions will undergo a **Single-Blind Peer Review** process with a minimum of two independent reviewers per submission.

Evaluation criteria include:

- Originality
- Scientific and technical quality
- Clarity of results
- Relevance to conference themes

Accepted contributions will be categorized as:

- Oral Presentations
  - Poster Presentations
  - Best Papers Track

## Oral Presentation

- 15 minutes presentation
- 5 minutes discussion and questions

## Poster Presentation

- Poster size: A0 or A1
